

How does your home currently get internet service?






Which cable/fiber-optic provider do you use for internet, phone, and/or TV at home?

Posed to all respondents who use cable/fiber optic providers for internet, phone and/or TV at home. (N=6723)




Which of the following services does your household pay a cable / fiber optic provider for? Select all that apply to you












